# **Privacy policy**

### 1. WHAT PERSONAL DATA DO WE PROCESS?

- 1.1 PPCD is collecting, processing and storing the personal data provided by you when creating your account at <a href="https://www.PPCD.dk">www.PPCD.dk</a>.
- 1.2 It includes the following personal data:
  - A. Full name,
  - B. E-mail address,
  - C. The business name of the licensee under whose license you are using the online tools at www.PPCD.dk.

## 2. WHAT DO WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA FOR?

- 2.1 We process the personal data about you for the following purposes:
  - A. Registering your account at www.PPCD.dk,
  - B. Providing you with our online tools available at www.PPCD.dk,
  - C. Communicating with you and the relevant licensee about our online tools and your account.

### 3. WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

- 3.1 We keep your personal data confidential and safe.
- 3.2 PPCD's employees and agents working with <a href="www.PPCD.dk">www.PPCD.dk</a> have access to your personal data. The licensee under whose license you are using the online tools at <a href="www.PPCD.dk">www.PPCD.dk</a> have access to your personal data.

- 3.3 We are only sharing your personal data when it is necessary to deliver our services to you.
- In the event we become legally obliged (due to a court order, proceedings by public authorities, etc.) to disclose your personal data, we will disclose such requested data and will immediately notify you.

### 4. FOR HOW LONG DO WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

4.1 We keep your data only for as long as it is needed for the purpose for which your data was registered and used, and as long as the law requires us to keep the information. For example, the Danish Accounting Act and the Danish VAT Act require us to store relevant bookkeeping information for a period of 5 years.

### 5. YOUR RIGHTS

- 5.5 You are entitled to have your data erased if the data is no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which it was collected.
